WALK DAY OUT Saturday 24th September 2011

BUXTON and POOLE'S CAVERN

Our final Walk Day Out of the year sees us heading north to the delightful Spa town of Buxton, right in the heart of the beautiful Peak District. In the morning, after coffee, we will be looking round the town, including the lovely Pavilion Gardens, then doing a pleasant country walk in all about 3 miles. After taking lunch independently in the town, there will be time for a little personal exploration before we make the short journey to Poole's Cavern.

Poole's Cavern is situated in Buxton Country Park and is reckoned to be the most spectacular cavern in the Peak District. There are vast natural chambers with striking stalactite and stalagmite formations, all imaginatively illuminated. We will be taken on the official Guided Tour after which there will be time for tea and a cake before we start on our journey home.

So, included in the cost for our Day Out will be

- Entrance to Poole's Cavern
- Services of an experienced Tour Manager (me)

Please note, Poole's Cavern has one or two slightly tricky steps. If for any reason you do not wish to visit Poole's Cavern, there will be a lead walk of about 1hr up through the woods to visit Solomon's Temple, a small folly from where there are panoramic views of Buxton. We will be leaving the Yenton at 8.30 am and Colmore Row at 8.45 am. We will be back in Birmingham at around 7 pm.
